



Director of Member Development, Board of Directors – Position Description

The Director of Member Development is responsible for the sustainability of the membership. Members support and guide the activities of the organization. Members often serve as volunteers on-stage, off-stage as well as in the general operation of the Society. The primary role of the Director of Member Development is to oversee training and development opportunities as well as assist with role descriptions for show-related roles. As such, the Director ensures that the Learning and Special Events Committee meets and reports to the Board as required. Through this committee, the Director may also oversee non-show musical theatre events and activities; however, this role should not overlap with the Managing Director's responsibility regarding public-facing events that provide outreach, market our brand and generate revenues, supporting our mission to grow our communities of performers, production personnel and audiences. The Director will also support membership sustainability by overseeing general non-show social events. The director will ensure that the Hospitality Committee meets and reports to the Board as required.
